

Brexit: The Notice Is Upon Us: Where Next?

Landmark Chambers will be holding a breakfast seminar to discuss issues arising from the recent White Paper "The United Kingdom's exit from and new partnership with the European Union" and the passage of the Bill authorising service of the Article 50 Notice through Parliament.

Speakers will include David Lock QC (chair), Richard Drabble QC, Samantha Broadfoot QC and Tim Buley. It appears likely that the Article 50 Notice will be served shortly before the seminar, on or about March 9th. Topics will include the possible contents of the Great Repeal Bill; how to deal with issues involving EU institutions in the UK legal framework; the distinction between the terms of exit from the EU and the negotiation of trade agreement; the relationship between the EU Article 50 timetable and domestic approval of the negotiation results.
