

Dover v CPRE and the duty to give reasons - Birmingham

The Supreme Court's judgment in *Dover District Council, China Gateway International Ltd v CPRE Kent* [2017] UKSC 79 marks an important new chapter in local planning authorities' duty to give reasons when granting planning permission. The judgment's ramifications are wide-ranging, and its practical implications for authorities, developers and other interested parties may be profound.

This seminar will assess the consequences of *Dover* with Neil Cameron QC, Matthew Reed QC and Zack Simons (all of whom appeared in the case) along with Jenny Wigley. It will include discussion of the other recent cases on reasons including *Oakley v South Cambridgeshire DC* and *Hawksworth Securities Plc v Peterborough City Council*.
